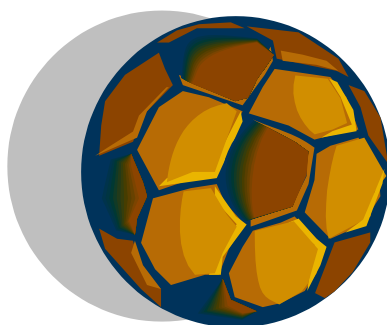

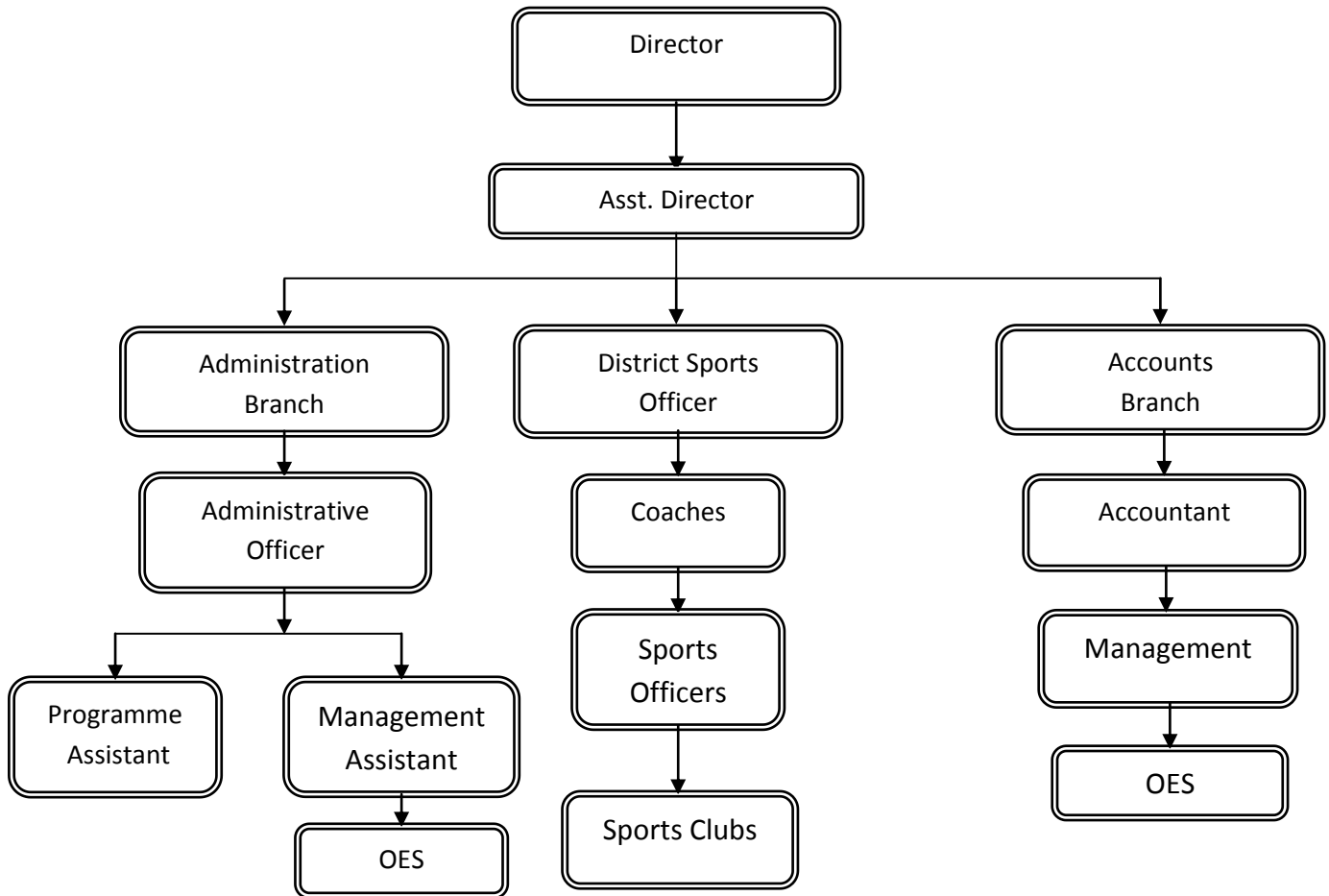

Training and Coaching Programme Organized in – 2009

All training and coaching programme are designed by the Department of Sports, Eastern Province and conducted at the Divisional, District and Provincial Level.

01. Divisional Training Programme

The divisional sports officers selected the Divisional Teams and provide training in various games for them to participate at the district level.

02. District Teams Training Programme

Coaching Programme in athletics and games were done at the District Level by coaches who were attached at the District Secretariat.

Stage I – Divisional Level

In every Divisional Secretariat we conducted Inter Club Competitions organized by our Sports Officers with the celebration of the respective Divisional Secretary. Divisional Sports Officers selected the Divisional Teams and gave proper training for them participate at the District Level.

Stage II – District Level

Inter Divisional Competition were held at the District Level organized by the District Sports Officer under the district supervision of the Government Agent of the District. Immediately after the competitions the selected teams have been given special training by the Department Coaches to participate in the Provincial Competitions organized by our Department of Sports.

Stage III – Provincial Level

The Provincial competition were conducted by the Department of Sports in respect of various competitions in three Districts were as planned. Later, we selected the Provincial teams to participate in the National Sports Festival. Details are given below.

Sammanthurai Presidential Cultural and Sports Complex

The Sports and Cultural Complex has been constructed from the funds allocated from the Hon. Excellency the President Secretariat.

The Complex has been established to promote sports & Cultural activities in the Eastern Province and a committee headed by the Secretary of the Ministry has been appointed by the Hon. Governor to Ensure Smooth and efficient functioning of the complex.

The establishment of the complex has given a boost to the development of sports and culture in the District and several Programmes are being implemented to benefit the Sportsmen & Artistes.

Special Coaching Camp

01. The Department of Sports has arranged the special coaching camp for Athletes. In all the three Districts of the Eastern Province the Coaching camps are conducted by the Department of Sports. The camps are targeted towards obtaining the best performance from our Sportsmen in the National Sports Festival.

02. The Swimming Coaching Camp held at Sport Complex Sammanthurai

Department of Sports was organized the special Coaching camp for physical Education Teachers & Sports Club members to develop their training abilities No of Sports Officers – 15, No of Physical Education Teachers – 75, No of Sports Club – 80 members were benefited from the programme.

03. Training Programme – Out Side of the country

We have facilitated the Eastern Province Sports Officer's to develop their carriers by providing them exposure to foreign training programmes. The officer had visited to Jordan and undergone training Pease throws Sports. This programme was sponsored by the Department of Sports and the expense of the officers was borne by the Provincial Council.
