### **1. History and Background**

The Eastern Provincial Ministry of Education, Cultural Affairs & Sports has been functioning in a building complex at Orr's hill from 2007. The powers and the functions of this Ministry are in keeping with the relevant sections as spelt out in the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the constitution of Republic of Sri Lanka. Most of the functions relating to education are devolved to the Provincial Council.

The Provincial Ministry of Education is the supreme administrative body of education in the province. The Ministry and the Provincial Department of Education, has a net work of 13 Educational Zonal Offices, 44 Divisional Education Offices. A Zonal Director of Education administrates each zone and a Divisional Education Officer manages each division. There is an approved cadre of 18,673 personnel as Teachers and Principals under the purview of the Ministry of Education, EP.

There are 1015 Schools with the student Population of 377,473 in the Eastern Province .Out of which 34 schools are more resourceful and directly managed by the Central Ministry of Education .Under these National School category, there are 09 schools in Trincomalee,10 schools in Baticaloa and 12 schools in Ampara districts.

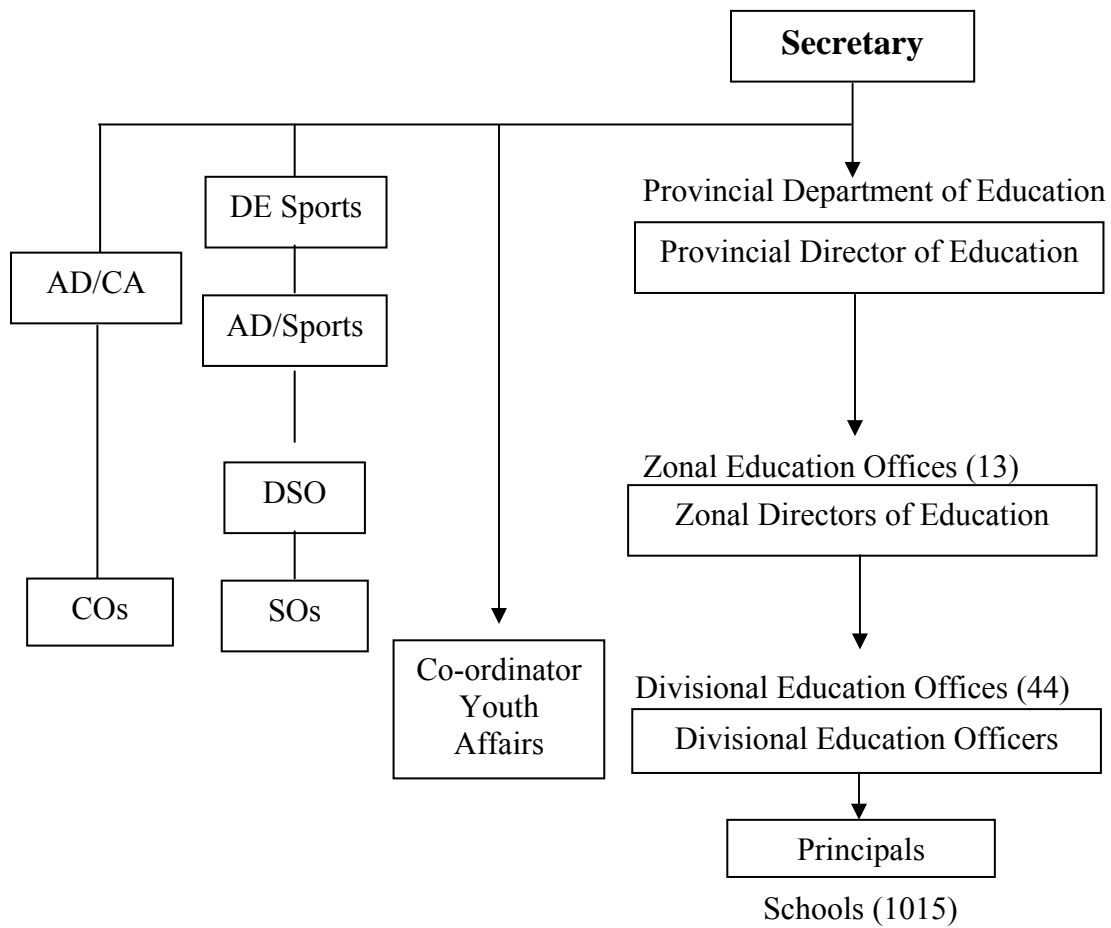

## 7. Achievements

### 7.1. Teacher Appointments in 2007

Two categories of Teacher Appointments were given in the 2007 year such as; College of Education Teachers and English Teachers. The total number of the 418 teachers recruited by the Ministry of Education, Cultural Affairs & Sports, Eastern Province. Out of which only 13 are English teachers.

### 7.2. Early Childhood Development Unit

**7.2.1** The training programmes were conducted for Early Childhood teachers at nine Education Zones. Such are Kalkudah, Batticaloa, Paddiruppu, Kalmunai, Akkraipattu, Sammanthurai, Ampara, Maha Oya & Dehiyattakandiya. 436 teachers have been benefited from these training programmes. This programme was funded by Ministry of Child Development, Women's Empowerment, and Colombo under the National action for Children for 2007.

**7.2.2** The workshop organized for ECD teachers at the 3 Education Zones in the Trincomalee District. 624 teachers got benefited from this workshop. This workshop was funded by Save the Children Fund, Trincomalee.

**7.2.3** The early childhood learning kits were supplied to all education zones in the Eastern Province. There were 160 sets of kits supplied under the National Action Plan for Children for 2007.

**7.2.4** The early childhood children exhibition organized at Dehiyattakandiya Education Zone by this unit. 11 Education Zones participated at the early childhood children exhibition.

**3.1.5.** Spectacles were provided to 386 students from 09 schools in Trincomalee district.

### **7.3. Grade – 9 Provincial Level Common Examinations**

The main purpose of this examination is to reduce the dropout at junior secondary level and to provide valuable results certificates at the end of the secondary level. It will help those who dropout after junior secondary level to seek appropriate job. The students sat for this examination through Tamil, Sinhala & English medium. There were 28,978 Students sat for this examination, out of which 236 students sat in English medium.

### **7.4. BESU Project**

Office of The Basic Education Sector Programme (BESU) special project unit was established in 2006. The following components of the projects were implemented during the year 2007.

- Remedial Teaching
- Psychosocial Care/ Support
- Second National Language Programme
- Peace and Value Education
- Disaster Risk Management

### **7.5. Non-formal Education**

561 school dance committees were reactivated in the eastern Province. Nearly 5700 non school going children identified. Out of these 2448 students admitted in the schools.

83 Skill development courses conducted at the zonal level. There were 1937 students benefited from these courses. In addition to this approximately 500 school leavers followed income generation course at the zonal level

### **7.6. Special Education**

The special education unit of the Provincial Department of education organized various programmes under Special Education Project.

5 medical camps conducted at Mutur, Batticaloa, Sammanthurai, Akkaraipattu and Paddiruppu for disable children. 350 children benefited from this Project

5 exhibitions organized at Trincomalee, Mutur, Kantale, Kalkudah and Ampara zones

12 disable day programmes organized at 12 educational zones in the Eastern Province.

### **7.10. Provincial level Mathematics Quiz competition**

The objectives of this competition are to improve the performance of mathematics at all level from grade 6 to 11 and motivate them for self learning practice and improve their self confidence.

In 2007 this quiz competition at provincial level was conducted and Dr.E.J.Satkunaraja was invited as chief guest and all the Zonal ADEE and ISAA were participated in the program. The wining students of this competition were awarded at the prize giving ceremony with gold, silver, brown medals and certificate by chief guest. Our financial target was **0.290** million and the total expenditure was **0.190** million.

### **7.11. Provincial level Science Quiz competition**

The objectives of this competition are to improve the performance level of science education, and to motivate the students to self learning and explore their knowledge.

The ministry has organized and conducted the Provincial level competition ceremonially on the 17th of November last year. All together 420 students participated in this competition. The winners were awarded with gold, silver, browns medals, and the provincial certificates. According to the reports, send by the zones the ministry has studied and identified by observation that there is change in performance level of the students due to this competitions.

### **7.12. Young Inventors Club Activities**

Sri Lanka Inventors Commission (SLIC) has conducted an exhibition cum competition of young inventors at T/ St,Mary's college, Trincomalee with the coordination of Provincial Department. The student inventors were requested to participate for the Provincial level competition directly and Trincomalee and Ampara district students were participated in the above Exhibition. The winners were awarded with gold medals and cash prize and the Principals of winning Schools, Teacher in charge and the Coordinators were also awarded for each winning Invention.

### **7.13. Information Communication Technology**

In the year 2007 the ministry did several activities to develop ICT Education. These activities are given below.

- Professional ICT training was provided for **557** teachers through SEMP and our financial target was Rs. **2,285,250.00**.
- Infrastructure facilities for three CRCs were provided through ESDFP and our financial target was Rs. **900,000.00**.
- **305** ICT Teacher Guides and CDs which were received from Ministry of Education were distributed to the zones.
- Infrastructure facilities had been provided for the Provincial Information Communication Technology Education center through the ESDFP and our financial target was Rs. **350,000.00**.
- Air-conditions of the Provincial Information Communication Technology center were repaired. The fund was provided by the ministry of Education. Financial target was Rs.**90,000.00** and the expenditure was Rs.**88,950.00**.
- **11** In service advisers (ISAA) for Information Communication Technology were appointed for **11** zones.

- a) Acute shortage Sri Lanka Educational Administrative Service (SLEAS) officers. Out of 227 agreed cadre for SLEAS, 149 posts are unfilled.
- b) There is acute shortage of Teachers for Mathematics, Science, English and Information Technology etc.
- c) Shortage of Non-formal Education Project Officers, out of 59 cadre, 54 posts are unfilled.
- d) Major problem is the Shortage of Minor employees in the schools.

### **Constrains**

- **Lack of Funds for maintenance for school buildings**
- **Zonal Education offices in EP need extensions or require additional building facilities**
- **Lack of Infrastructure facilities in the schools affected by the conflict.**
- Shortage of Furniture in schools such as students' sets Teachers' sets, Black boards and Cupboards.
- Shortage of equipments and other quality inputs for teaching – learning activities
- Shortage of Teacher quarters in isolated schools.
- Shortage basic sanitary facilities in schools such as Toilets, Urinals and Drinking Water.
